EXPANSION OF THE LIST OF GOODS PROHIBITED FOR IMPORTATION TO THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

Updated information on the list of products prohibited for import into the Russian Federation in order to implement the Presidential Decree N 560 of 06 August 2014, N 320 dated 24 June 2015, N 305 of 29 June 2013 and N 293 of 30 June 2017.

I. BACKGROUND

On 13 August 2014 IRU informed its members of the trade sanctions that have been imposed by the Russian Federation with regards to the certain goods originated from the USA, EU countries, Norway, Canada and Australia (see document ref. [CLTM/BR2913/SCO](#), which has also been sent to the CAD members by email).

II. INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS

We hereby inform you that the Decree of the Government of the Russian Federation No. 1292, 25 October 2017, **has supplemented the list of agricultural products**, raw materials and food products originated from the USA, EU countries, Canada, Australia, Norway, Ukraine, Albania, Montenegro, Iceland and Liechtenstein, which are prohibited for importation on the territory of the Russian Federation, **with the following items:**

0103 (except 0103 10 000 0)	Live swine (excluding purebred breeding animals)
0206 (except 0206 10 100 0, 0206 22 000 1, 0206 29 100 0, 0206 30 000 1, 0206 30 000 3, 0206 41 000 1, 0206 49 000 1, 0206 80 100 0, 0206 90 100 0 ¹)	Edible offal of bovine animals, swine, sheep, goats, horses, asses, mules or hinnies, fresh, chilled or frozen (excluding goods for the production of pharmaceutical products ¹)
0209	Pig fat, free of lean meat, and poultry fat, not rendered or otherwise extracted, fresh, chilled, frozen, salted, in brine, dried or smoked
1501	Pig fat (including lard) and poultry fat, other than that of heading under 0209 or 1503
1502	Fats of bovine animals, sheep or goats, other than those of heading under 1503
1503 00	Lard stearin, lard oil, oleostearin, oleo-oil and tallow oil, not emulsified or mixed or otherwise prepared

¹ Except for the goods intended for the production of pharmaceutical products upon confirmation of the intended purpose of the imported goods, carried out by the Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Russian Federation in accordance with the procedure established by the Ministry. For the purposes of applying this position, it is necessary to be guided both by the FEACN EAEU (Foreign Economic Activity Commodity Classification of the Eurasian Economic Union) and by the item of the good.
