

EU-Western Balkans Summit - protests of Bulgarian road transport operators

Bulgaria (May 17, 2018)

The EU-Western Balkans Summit, which will take place on 17 May 2018 in Sofia and will be hosted by the Bulgarian Presidency of the Council of the EU, will bring together the Heads of the EU Member States and their counterparts from the Western Balkan region. The Presidents of the Council and of the Commission, Mr. Donald Tusk and Mr. Jean-Claude Juncker will participate as well.

During this event, protests of Bulgarian road transport operators against the EC Mobility Package will be held in Sofia and in the cities of Plovdiv, Vidin, Russe, Pleven, V. Turnovo, Vratza, Svilengrad, as well as at the Bulgarian - Greece border crossing points Kulata and Ilinden.

Road and border crossings blockades are not envisaged, nevertheless many trucks and coaches will be parked in the right lanes of main boulevards in the mentioned cities, where traffic delays are expected.
