Bulgaria: Opening of all Bulgarian-Greek border crossing points

Bulgaria - Greece (February 22, 2016)

The six-day counter-blockade which Bulgarian carriers implemented at the Bulgarian-Greek border as a countermeasure against the continued closing of border crossings by protesting Greek farmers was lifted on Sunday afternoon. The decision was taken during a meeting of the Bulgarian international drivers and hauliers' Initiative Committee.

A meeting is expected to take place later today between protesting Greek farmers and the Greek Prime Minister, Alexis Tsipras.

At 9:00 this morning, the queue of waiting vehicles at Kulata checkpoint was 6 kms long. There are no queues at the other border crossing points.
