Blockades and protests in France. Potential fuel shortage

Strikes and blockades at oil refineries are still ongoing in France. The entire territory is affected by a potential oil shortage.

At least one fuel station out of four is currently out of fuel.

Also motorway blockades and protests at fuel refineries are causing problems truck in the Calais area.

Many fuel stations near the French port had run dry and drivers have been struggling to fill their tanks, visiting several stations before finding fuel and being allowed to buy only a limited amount.

More strikes and protests are planned for Tuesday 24 May and Thursday 26 May, with disruption expected at ports, airports and on rail lines. Rail workers have announced rolling strikes every Wednesday and Thursday until July.
