

Italy starts enforcing the CJEU decision on banning regular weekly rest in the cabin

Italy (May 08, 2018)

On 30 April 2018, the Italian Ministry of Interior issued a statement regarding the Court of Justice of the European Union decision, which took place on 20 December 2017 enforcing the ban to have the regular weekly rest period in the cabin.

In the event of an infringement, the sanction is the same as the weekly rest is not taken. Therefore, the Italian Traffic Code is applied, under Article 174, paragraph 7, which foresees a fine ranging from €422 to €1.686 following a roadside check.
