

BREXIT: Operation Brock - Driving to the Port of Dover or Eurotunnel

United Kingdom

There are contingency plans to manage freight traffic on the major roads leading to the Port of Dover and Eurotunnel. These plans, activated in times of cross-Channel disruption, are known as Operation Brock. If the UK leaves the EU without a deal, Operation Brock may be activated if there are significant delays at the border between Dover and Calais.

Before you travel, check if delays are possible at the Port of Dover and Eurotunnel and check if Operation Brock is active. If Operation Brock is active, <u>check online</u> for advice and look out for road signs telling you where to go.

Plan ahead if you travel during Operation Brock.
