



G7 Summit in Biarritz - driving restrictions, 24-26/08

France

Special driving restrictions will apply during the G7 Summit that will take place in Biarritz from August 24th to August 26th 2019 (Saturday to Monday).

For security reasons, **local circulation will be prohibited for all vehicles in the city centre** of Biarritz during these three days. Local traffic will be totally transferred to the A63 motorway.

To facilitate transit on the **A63** motorway, **specific driving restrictions will apply to the following categories of goods transport vehicles:**

1. Traffic ban for >7.5t trucks on A63 both directions between Biriadou (1) and St Geours de Maremne (9) on Saturday, August 24th 2019 from 7pm to 8pm
2. Traffic ban for >19t trucks and hazardous material on Monday, August 26th from 11am to 6pm on A63 both directions between:
 - Biriadou (1) and St Geours de Maremne (9),
 - on N134/ N1134 between Urdos and Somport Tunnel,
 - on D934 between Laruns and Pourtalet pass.

The traffic ban will be lifted for >7.5t trucks on A63, southward direction from St Geours de Maremne (9) to Biriadou (1), on Sunday, August 25th 2019 from 0am to 8am.

Usual derogations will apply during this period (including transport of live animals and perishable goods).
