

Updated on coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak - Romania

Latest news from Romania:

The Romanian Minister of Internal Affairs announced yesterday evening that starting from Friday, 13th of March 2020, 12h00, several secondary border crossing points will be closed, as part of a government strategy to fight against the spread of COVID - 19.

The following border crossing points which are closed:

- Border crossing points with Hungary: Turnu, Săcuieni, Salonta and Valea lui Mihai
- Border crossing points with Ukraine: Sighet
- Border crossing points with Bulgaria: Negru Vodă, Lipniţa, Dobromir, Zimnicea, Turnu Măgurele and Bechet
- Border crossing points with Moldova: Rădăuţi Prut and Oancea On Thursday, 12th March 2020, the Serbian authorities closed, unilaterally, the following border points with Romania: Porţile de Fier 2, Moldova Nouă, Foieni, Lunga, Vâlcani, Drobeta Turnu Severin and Naidăş
