An online guide has been created to inform you whether you are allowed to drive your truck, articulated vehicle or self-propelled machine on Austrian motorways. The query also takes into account regional environmental driving bans. There is also a quick query for the most important transit routes (see below).

Environmental zones:

To enter the environmental zone, each vehicle concerned requires a valid Austrian environmental sticker (Umwelt-Pickerl). The sticker must be displayed on the vehicle, if it is not, you could receive a fine of up to EUR 2180. The sticker is currently valid in seven environmental zones: Vienna, Upper Austria, Lower Austria, Styria, Tyrol, Linz and Burgenland.
